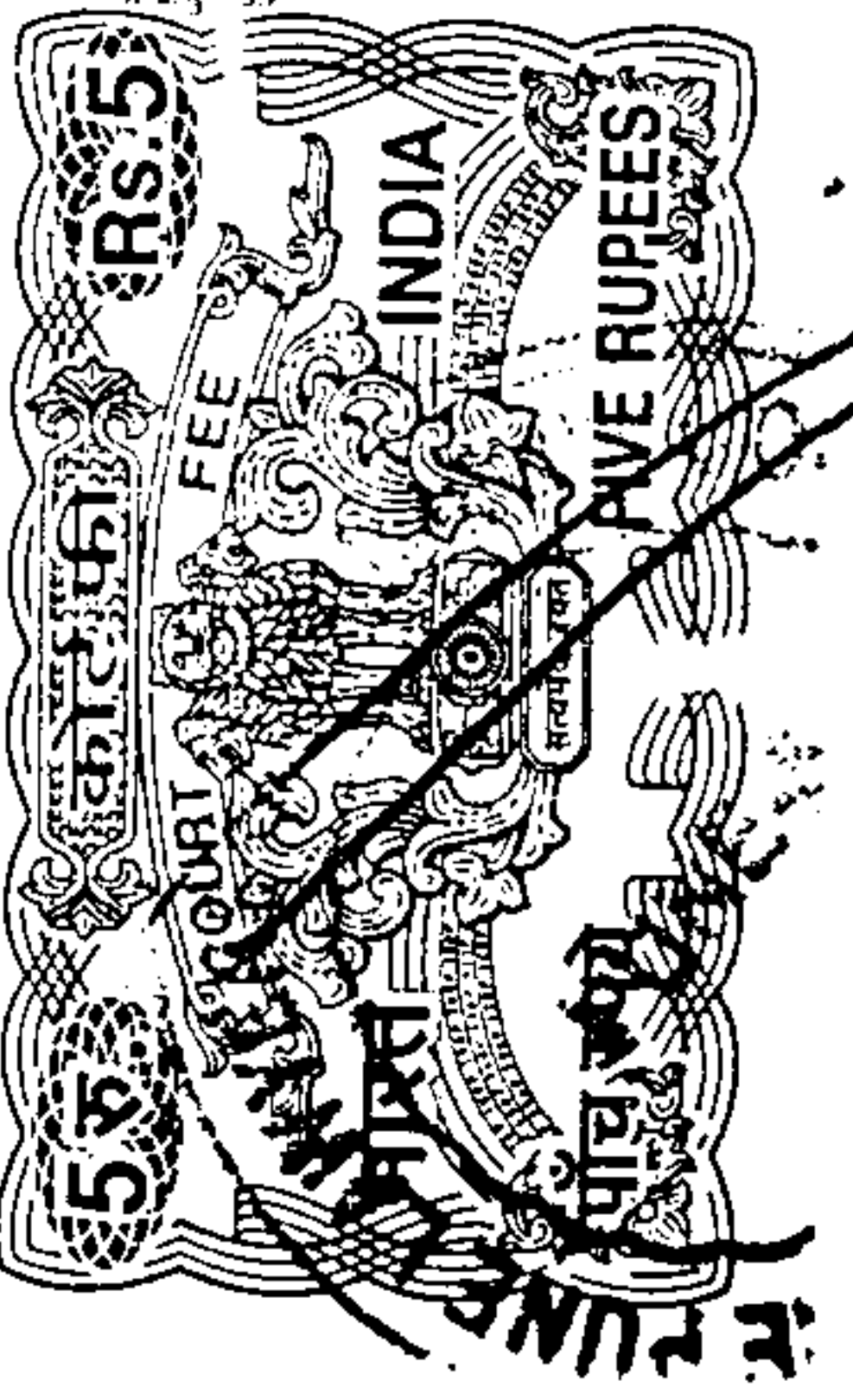
- 1) That present Applicant / Accused came to be arrested on 30/08/2015 in the offence registered at Chandan Nagar Police Station vide C. R. No. 156/2015 for the offence punishable U/s. 307 r/w. 34 of IPC. During investigation police machinery have added section 120 (B) of IPC and u/s. 4 (25) of Arms Act and u/s. 37 (1) r/w. 135 of B. P. Act. Thereafter the Applicant / Accused was produced before Learned JMFC Court and

received
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- D) That considering the FIR itself, the Applicant was not present on the spot and he has not assaulted Complainant by any weapon.
- E) That during investigation nothing incriminating has been recovered from the instance of present Applicant, which clearly shows that Applicant has been falsely implicated.
- F) That the Applicant is brother in law of the Complainant and by putting grudge in mind of previous transaction, he has been falsely implicated by the Complainant, only to grab handloan amount, which has been given by the Applicant to Complainant.
- G) That the Applicant / Accused is no where concern with the alleged crime.
- H) That there is no nexus of Co Accused with present Applicant / Accused.
- I) That there is no any motive and / or intention to commit the alleged offence.
- J) That there is no any single evidence to show that the involvement of Applicant.
- K) That there is no any specific role attributed against the Applicant / Accused.
- L) That there is no any criminal antecedents against the Applicant / Accused.
- M) That the Applicant / Accused is having small children, old parents, who are solely dependent upon the Applicant for their livelihood.
- N) That investigation of the crime has been completed and IO has filed charge sheet.
- O) That the Applicant is permanent resident of given address and hence no question of abscondance.

ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT NO. 6
IN SESSIONS CASE NO. 752/2015

1] This is a bail application filed by applicant accused Sanjay Laxman Padval u/S 439 of Criminal Procedure Code in connection with CR No. 156/2015 (Sessions Case No. 752/2015) registered with Chandannagar Police Station for the offence punishable under Section 307 r/w 34 of Indian Penal Code for grant of regular bail.

2] In short it is the case of prosecution that complainant Hiranman Kakade is a businessman. He is running a Herbal Medical Shop at Kharadi. On 23.08.2015 he lodged the report. It is alleged that on 22.08.2015 at about 8.00 p.m., he parked his INNOVA car in the parking area. He wants to purchase shampoo. He went to Anand Medical Store and purchased shampoo. He was returning to home. He reached in front of Reliance Crase Shop. Unknown two persons came from his behind and attacked on him by scythe from back side. They caused injuries to him and fled away. Accordingly offence vide Cr No. 156/2015 came to be registered. A supplementary statement was recorded on 08.09.2015. The Investigating Officer after due investigation filed charge sheet against the applicant accused and co-accused. He recovered three scythes from Izaz Ebrahim Shaikh, one scythe from co-accused Anil Sanjay Gaikwad u/S 27 of Evidence Act. He collected the injury certificate of Hiranman Kakade and filed the charge sheet. During the course of investigation, it transpired that the applicant accused Sanjay Laxman Padval is brother-in-law of complainant. Applicant accused Sanjay Padval was of the opinion that the complainant Hiranman has developed illicit relations with his wife. Therefore, applicant accused Sanjay Padval hatched criminal

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be said that he is out of danger. Therefore, he is entitled for bail. On this point I am relying upon 2015, (1) Bombay Criminal Cases, 450 Lakhya @ Nikhil Prakash Kshirsagar V/s. State of Maharashtra. This apart, the name of the accused is not appearing in the FIR nor even in the supplementary statement of the complainant. There is no direct evidence against the applicant accused. As per FIR the complainant Hiranman was assaulted by two persons only. Here in this case police arrested 11 accused and filed the charge sheet. There is no satisfactory explanation against the total 11 accused persons. Whatever evidence appears, it appears to be circumstantial against the applicant accused. Therefore, I hold that keeping the applicant accused behind the bar, would not be helpful to the prosecution. There is no prima facie case against the applicant accused. Therefore, following order.

ORDER

- 1] The application is allowed.
- 2] Applicant accused Sanjay Laxman Padval ~~Jogdand~~ in connection with C.R. No. 156/2015 registered at Chandannagar be enlarged on bail on furnishing PB and SB of Rs. 50000/- with one or two sureties of like amount.
- 3] That he shall not influence the prosecution witnesses in any manner whatsoever.
- 4] That he shall attend the Court as and when the matter is fixed unless his presence is specifically exempted from the Court.
